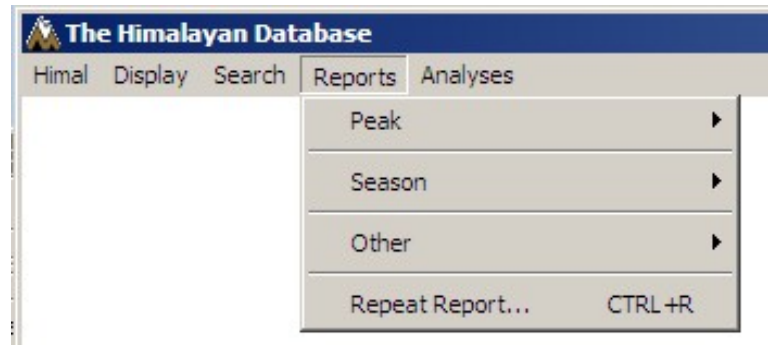

Appendix G: Reports

There are three groups of reports in the Himalayan Database:

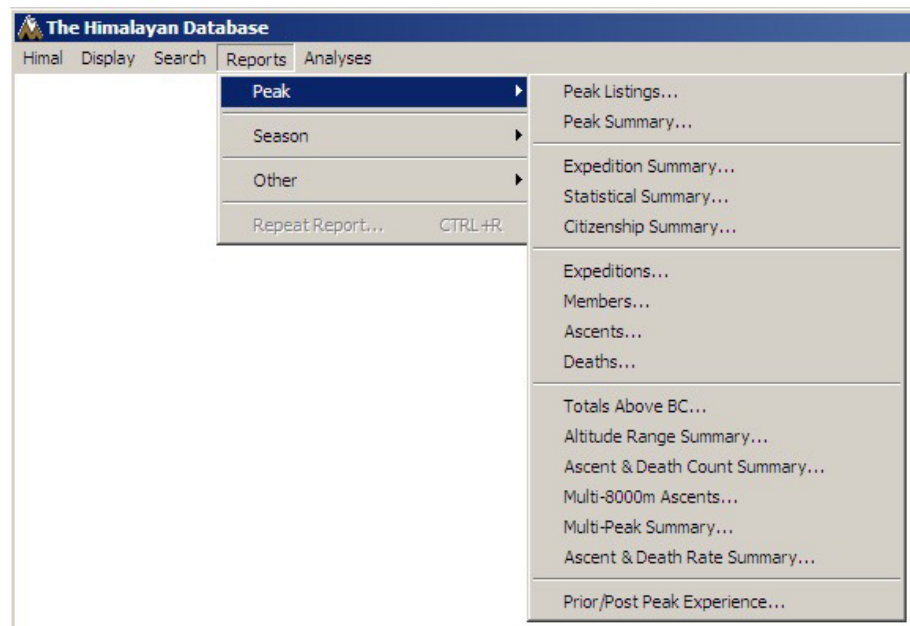
- (1) **Peak** reports that are organized around peak information;
- (2) **Season** reports that are organized around climbing seasons;
- (3) **Other** reports that do not fit into the two groups above.

These commands are in the **Reports** menu:



Peak Reports

The **Peak** submenu offers several varieties of peak reports:




The most recent report can be repeated by selecting Repeat Report from the Reports menu. The previous report dialog box will appear with the last set of selected options, which can then be modified. This can be very useful when running a series of reports where only one or two options are being varied.

Peak Listings

The **Peak Listings** report lists the peaks in the database along with their peak ID and either their names and locations within Nepal or with information about their first ascent, depending on the format selected.

Select the options that you want in the options dialog box.

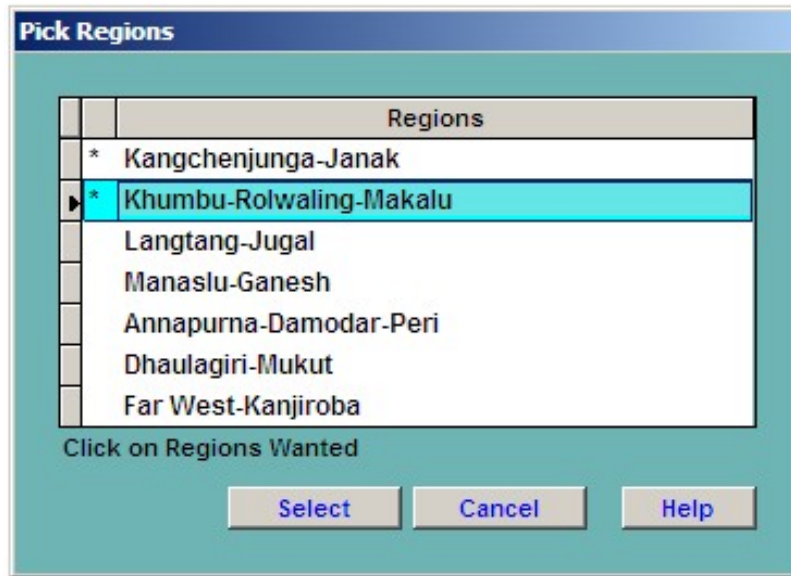

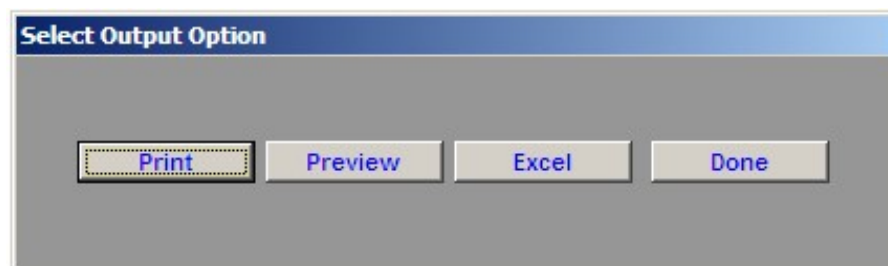
Combinations (multiple selections) can be made for the Region option. Clicking on the Combinations choice will bring up a Pick Regions dialog, from which you can select multiple items. In the example below, Kangchenjunga and Khumbu are selected (as indicated by the "*" to the left of their names).



You may adjust the size of the preview screen on your monitor by using the standard resize boxes on the report window or the Zoom button in the Print Preview box at the top of the report. The navigation buttons in the Print Preview box allow you to page through a multi-page report.

When you are finished looking at the preview, close the preview screen by clicking the close box in the upper right corner of the report window.

From the Select Output Option box, you can then print the report, preview again, or create an Excel spreadsheet file:

The defaults for the altitude range (5000m-8850m) and year range include all peaks and expeditions in the database. You may change these to narrow the ranges covered. In addition, an individual peak may be specified.

The Region option is fully described for the Peak Listing report.

The Standard Format with 95% Confidence Intervals only gives the Adjusted Wald 95% confidence values in the Excel output file. These may be useful for statistical analyses that show the reliability of the output values based on sample sizes.

Routes may be chosen for the commercial AMCE (Ama Dablam, Manaslu, Cho Oyu, Everest) peaks and the other 8000m peaks.

Multiple seasonal ascents refer to the inclusion of second and third ascents by a single climber on the same peak in the same climbing season.

The printed output file is the same as for the Standard Format.

The Routes option applies only to the commercial AMCE (Ama Dablam, Manaslu, Cho Oyu, Everest) peaks and the other 8000m peaks.

Trekking peaks are normally excluded from the summary for years that they were classified as such, unless requested.

Multiple seasonal ascents refer to the inclusion of second and third ascents by a single climber on the same peak in the same climbing season.

Peaks with no attempts can be excluded, if requested.
